## THE ORGANISATION

The Housing Alliance is a collaboration of six of Ireland's largest Approved Housing Bodies (AHBs): Circle Voluntary Housing, Clúid Housing Co-operative Housing Ireland, Oaklee Housing, Respond and Tuath Housing.
